Why were these people taken away everything, which they have ever known or loved?

The past four decades brought much suffering and hardship to the Kingdom of Cambodia. In 1998, over thirty years of constant civil war came to an end, but the damage had already been done. Cambodia was left devastated, and today is still struggling to recover.

Today, the vast majority of Cambodians live scattered throughout the countryside managing on less than \$1 USD a day. This part of the population survives on subsidiary rice farming and other agrarian jobs (small scale animal production and fruit and vegetable farming). A bamboo and thatch hut built on stilts (for protection from the frequent flooding that occurs during monsoon season) is home for these families.



#### Medical Care

Sen Soursdey Medical Clinic and Just for Asia are not the only way that offers medical care. SMC and JFA employs ten Cambodian on their staff, Ps. Rathana and Dr. Ponna and their staff are responsible for overseeing the medical care of all the poor people. They also regularly treat the desperate and needy throughout Cambodia. SMC also need one car that is utilized to provide the best medical care possible to reach out to other place.

Nevertheless, from time to time, it is necessary for us to make upgrades to our technology. As I'm writing this, **we are in need of the following items to be donated - used or new.**
